Obituary of the Member of the Ameer's Office, Ustadh Ahmad Bakr (Abu Osama)

The Ameer of Hizb ut Tahrir, Members of the Ameer's Office, the Diwan of Al-Madhalim (Grievances), and the Central Media Office and Hizb ut Tahrir in general mourns to the Islamic Ummah the member of the Ameer's Office, Ustadh Ahmad Bakr (Abu Osama) who passed away this morning, the 22nd of Rabi` Al-Awwal 1447 AH corresponding to the 14 September 2025 CE, at the age of eighty-seven years.

Abu Osama was from the first generation of Hizb ut Tahrir who carried the Dawah for the sake of Allah to resume the Islamic way of life by the establishment of the Khilafah Rashidah (rightly-guided Caliphate) State.
