Police Killings: A Capitalist Mindset of Brutality and Impunity

Three police officers in Kenya have been charged with the murder of a 31-year-old blogger who died in police custody earlier this month. Albert Ojwang's death has sparked outrage in Kenya with protests held to demand justice.

We, in Hizb ut Tahrir Kenya, would like to highlight the following:

The security agents under any Secular-Liberal Regimes such as Kenya are an extension of a colonial-era creation that the British used to control the population and stamp out dissent. During the 1950s, as Kenyans began to assert their right to rule themselves, the police and other British-run security services rounded up tens of thousands of Kenyans and hanged more than a thousand.

Apparently, the police force views ordinary citizens as potential threat to ruling administration an approach that was originally established to enforce colonial rule—not to protect citizens.

Ideologically, the secular-liberal regimes perceive benefit and interest sacred above human life and properties, thus making corruption, impunity and state capture as political norm. With this in mind, states apparatus killings with impunity is the only means to curb any voice of dissent and efforts to expose mass corruption. It is worth mentioning the brutality and torture by state apparatus is a global trend and not unique to Kenya.

We insist that human lives or rather all lives are sacred which deserve an ultimate protection by the state without fear or favor. In Islam, the protection of human life is paramount and is considered a sacred trust from the Almighty Allah. Islam emphasizes the sanctity of life, prohibiting the unjust taking of it, and requires the preservation of life and dignity for all human beings.

We reiterate that it is only under Khilafah Raashida (rightly guided Caliphate) which will be soon reestablished upon the methodology of Prophethood, the police force would be responsible for maintaining public order, enforcing laws, and investigating crimes. Torture is absolutely forbidden and any police officer found guilty of carrying out physical abuse or torture against any citizen, Muslim or non-Muslim, will be held accountable. Hence, the police forces will be fully committed to maintain law and order; hence, protecting the lives and property of the citizens.

A Visit of Betrayal

Trump embraces Pakistan: ‘Tactical romance’ or a new ‘inner circle’?

Trump hosts Pakistan army chief Asim Munir for an unprecedented White House lunch, as the US and Pakistan reset ties. (<https://www.aljazeera.com/>)

Comment:

At a time when the Muslim world is bleeding—from Gaza to Kashmir, to the streets of Tehran—General Asim Munir’s visit to U.S. President Donald Trump is not only tone-deaf but a betrayal of immense proportions. The meeting, held at the White House and framed by Trump as an expression of gratitude for Munir’s role in de-escalating a near-war with India, is being hailed by segments of the Pakistani establishment as a strategic diplomatic move.

In truth, it marks yet another chapter in the humiliating legacy of Pakistan’s military elite bowing before Western powers—even as those very powers arm and defend the Zionist regime in its latest wave of brutal aggression across the Middle East.

Trump’s welcoming of Munir comes in the wake of U.S.-backed ‘Israeli’ strikes inside Iran, which have killed hundreds. Yet rather than challenging U.S. complicity in this bloodshed, Munir extended a hand to the same Trump who funds and arms the Zionist entity, authorized drone strikes across Muslim lands, and once branded Pakistan a nation of “lies and deceit.” The general’s presence in Washington reveals the extent to which Pakistan’s leadership has become complicit in a global system of colonialist domination.

This visit reflects decades of policy in which Pakistan’s military leaders have prioritized maintaining favor with Washington over standing with the Ummah. Trump himself made it clear that his administration values Pakistan primarily for its strategic leverage against Iran and for helping contain the conflict with India—interests that serve U.S. hegemony, not the Islamic Ummah.

What makes this betrayal even more painful is the disconnect between the sacrifices and deep love for Islam among Pakistan’s people and the actions of its leadership. There is open betrayal and a blatant

disregard for the obligation to submit to Allah’s commands, to treat the enemies of the Ummah as enemies, to defend Muslim lands, and to avenge their martyrs. That duty, in this case, has been shamelessly forsaken.

To the Muslims in Pakistan and to their extension within our community: we remind you that true leadership does not kneel before the enemies of Islam, nor sit silently as Palestine and Kashmir burn, and now Iran bleeds. The way forward lies in a complete political and ideological break from American dictates. Only through the reestablishment of the Khilafah (Caliphate) upon the method of Prophethood can Pakistan’s military strength be harnessed to liberate occupied lands, safeguard sanctities, and restore justice to the Ummah. Until then, every handshake with a war criminal like Trump will remain a painful reminder of how far Pakistan’s leadership has strayed from its Islamic obligations.

It is a Great Sin for the Jews' Aircraft to Cross the Airspace of the Regimes, to Bomb Iran and Return Safely Without Being Intercepted by these Regimes Even by a Single Shot!

Trump stated in a post on the Truth Social platform: ["Iran and Israel should make a deal, and will make a deal, just like I got India and Pakistan to make." He continued: "Likewise, we will have PEACE, soon, between Israel and Iran! Many calls and meetings now taking place."(Sky News,15/6/2025). On Sunday, a spokesperson for the Jewish entity's military said via X platform that "Israel issued a warning to Iranxians living near nuclear reactors in Iran to evacuate their homes." Meanwhile, an 'Israeli' military spokesman said that the army bombed a nuclear facility in the city of Isfahan, central Iran. Since dawn on Sunday, Iran began launching new rounds of missiles at targets inside 'Israel', causing deaths and dozens of injuries, and causing significant destruction to homes and buildings. In response, Tehran has been subjected to 'Israeli' attacks. (Al Jazeera,15/6/2025).

The Jewish entity announced on Saturday, 14/6/2025, that 9 scientists and experts in the Iranian nuclear program were killed during its raids on the country, thus raising the previously announced death toll, they are: Ali Bakhoy Karimi, Mansour Askari, and Saeed Borji, who are experts in mechanics, physics, and materials engineering, respectively, in raids on Friday, according to the army. This came in an announcement confirmed by the semi-official Iranian Tasnim News Agency. The Jewish entity had launched "an unprecedented attack on Iran at dawn on Friday, 13/6/2025, targeting the heart of the Iranian nuclear program and senior military leaders. While Iran confirmed that it launched hundreds of missiles on Friday evening at the beginning of its response to Israel." (CNN, 14/6/2025)

Immediately after the Jewish attack, US President Donald Trump declared on Friday, 13/6/2025: ["The Israeli attack on Iran has been excellent," calling on it to conclude an agreement on its nuclear program. In response to a question from ABC: "Is there an American role in the attack on Iran?" he said, "I don't want to answer that." He said on the Truth Social platform, "Iran must make a deal, before there is nothing left, and save what was once known as the Iranian Empire." He added that he warned Tehran that "The United States makes the best and most lethal military equipment anywhere in the world by far ... Israel has a lot of it, with much more to come — and they know how to use it." In similar statements, Trump said: "Today is day 61. I told them what to do, but they just couldn't get there. Now they have, perhaps, a second chance!" (Al Jazeera, 13/6/2025)]

By contemplating these events, the following becomes clear:

1- It is clear from these events that the Jews did not attack Iran except at the behest of Trump's America, as his statements clearly state this. This is certain and expected, for the Jews have no power on their own, nor are they capable of fighting. Allah the Almighty, the Exalted, is Most Truthful:

لَنْ يَضُرُّوَكُمْ إِلَّا أَدَىٰ وَإِنْ يَفَاتِلُوكُمْ يُؤْتِكُمُ الْأَدْبَارَ ثُمَّ لَا يُنصِرُونَ * ضَرَبَتْ عَلَيْهِمُ الدَّلَّةُ أَيَّنَ مَا تَقَفُوا إِلَّا بِحَبْلِ مِنَ اللَّهِ وَحَبْلِ مِنَ النَّاسِ وَبَاغُوا بِغَضَبٍ مِنَ اللَّهِ وَضَرَبَتْ عَلَيْهِمُ الْمَسَكِنَةَ

"They can never inflict harm on you, except a little annoyance, but if they meet you in battle, they will flee and they will have no helpers * They will be stricken with disgrace wherever they go, unless they are protected by a covenant with Allah or a treaty with the people. They have invited the displeasure of Allah and have been branded with misery" [Aal-i-Imran: 111-2]. Thus, since their earliest ages, they have cut off the rope of Allah after the times of their prophets. And they are the same in the modern era, as Britain adopted them since the First World War, then they moved to the embrace of America after the Second World War. All their wars speak of that, for they are by the rope of the people... Trump's support for them in their attack on Iran is clear from Trump's statements above to anyone who has a heart or who listens attentively.

2- Then what is greater than this and more disastrous and bitter is that the planes of the Jews crossed the airspace of the ruling regimes in the Muslim countries surrounding the Jewish entity, which destroyed and killed while in Iran and then returned to the occupied land in security and peace. Not a single shot was fired at these planes by the rulers around them in Ash-Sham, Iraq, Egypt, Turkey and from everywhere... Thus, they transgress and attack being safe, going and returning, and the rulers in the Muslim countries watched what was happening without moving. They forgot or pretended to forget the consequences of the crime of their silence.

[سَيُصِيبُ الَّذِينَ أَجْرَمُوا صَغَارٌ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ وَعَذَابٌ شَدِيدٌ بِمَا كَانُوا يَمْكُرُونَ]

"The wicked will soon be overwhelmed by humiliation from Allah and a severe punishment for their evil plots" [Al-An'am: 124]. It is a grave sin that the Jewish planes cross the airspace of the agent rulers, carry out their attacks and return without being intercepted by any of these rulers.

3- Every sane person realizes that the best means of defence against the Jews is attack. The Jews have been threatening Iran for a long time, especially in recent days. Trump even hinted and even declared that the Jews would attack Iran's nuclear facilities. However, Iran did not launch an offensive response against the Jews, in defence of Iran, and to ward off these threats from America and the Jews. This is truly astonishing!! Iran remained silent until its facilities were attacked and its scientists were killed, and then it began to respond. Despite all of the successive attacks, Trump continues to declare, "Likewise, we will have PEACE, soon, between Israel and Iran! Many calls and meetings now taking place." (Sky News, 15/6/2025)! We warn against this war leading to any peace with the Jewish entity, rather, as Allah said:

[فَإِمَّا تَثَقَّفَتْهُمْ فِي الْحَرْبِ فَشَرِّدْ بِهِمْ مَنْ خَلْفَهُمْ]

"If you ever encounter them in battle, make a fearsome example of them, so perhaps those who would follow them may be deterred" [Al-Anfal:57].

4- But what is truly heart-breaking are the Ruwaibidha (insignificant ignorant) rulers in Muslim countries, especially those surrounding the Jewish entity occupying Palestine. They surround them, so how can they not see the Jewish planes crossing over their heads, bombing Muslim countries and returning safe and secure without a single shot being fired?! Rather, they are as if they are a neutral party observing what is happening, as if they are in some faraway land, not in Muslim lands! These rulers are in state of demise and that is not surprising, as they are at the beck and call of the kafir (disbelieving) colonialist countries, especially America.

They say what they say and do what they want. They justify inaction and sanctify borders, and they forgot or pretended to forget that the lands of Muslims are one, whether they are in the farthest part of the earth or the nearest! And that the peace of the believers is one, and their war is one. It is not right that they are divided by their schools of Islamic thoughts, as long as they are Muslims, as they are one Ummah:

[إِنَّ هَذِهِ أُمَّتُكُمْ أُمَّةً وَاحِدَةً وَأَنَا رَبُّكُمْ فَاعْبُدُون]

"O prophets! Indeed, this religion of yours is 'only' one, and I am your Lord, so worship Me 'alone'." [Al-Anbya: 92].

How can enemy aircraft fly over the airspace of the rulers in Muslim countries and bomb another Muslim country while they remain silent?! The most exemplary of these is the way of those who watch enemy aircraft coming and going as if they are neutral or closer to the Jews! Moreover, even though these rulers hear Trump's statement, not his hints, that the Jewish entity is fighting with the rope from America (support), its orders, and its

weapons, yet none of them dares to sever relations with America, at the very least.

[أَلَا سَاءَ مَا يَحْكُمُونَ]

"Evil indeed is their judgment!" [An-Nahl: 59]

5- Despite all this, these Ruwaibidha (insignificant ignorant rulers) will disappear and the Islamic State, the Khilafah Rashidah (Rightly-Guided Caliphate), will return as the first state in the world, spreading goodness in it, Allah willing. Fighting the Jews and removing their occupation will happen, Allah willing, as the Truthful, the Trusted One (saw) said in Musnad Ahmad on the authority of Hudhayfah:

«نَمْ تَكُونُ خِلَافَةً عَلَىٰ مِنْهَاجِ النَّبِيِّ...»

"...then there will be Khilafah (Caliphate) on the method of Prophethood." Likewise, Al-Bukhari extracted on the authority of Abdullah ibn Umar, may Allah be pleased with them both, who said: I heard the Messenger of Allah (saw) say:

«...تَقَاتِلُكُمْ الْيَهُودُ فَتَسْلُطُونَ عَلَيْهِمْ»

"The Jews will fight you. You will gain such control over them." It was also narrated by Muslim with the wording on the authority of Ibn Umar, on the authority of the Prophet (saw) who said:

«..لَتَقَاتِلَنَّ الْيَهُودَ فَلَتَقْتُلَنَّاهُمْ»

"You shall fight the Jews. You will kill them." Then the earth will shine with Allah's victory, the Strong, the Mighty, the Wise.

[إِنَّ فِي ذَلِكَ لَذِكْرًا لِمَنْ كَانَ لَهُ قَلْبٌ أَوْ أَلْقَى السَّمْعَ وَهُوَ شَهِيدٌ]

"Surely in this is a reminder for whoever has a 'mindful' heart and lends an attentive ear" [Qaf: 37]

In conclusion, Hizb ut Tahrir, the pioneer who does not lie to his people, calls upon you to support it and work with it to restore the Khilafah Rashidah once again, so that Islam and its people will be honoured and disbelief (kufr) and its people will be humiliated, and that will be the great victory.

Question:

Recent days have witnessed a remarkable development in the war. Drones attacked Port Sudan, the administrative capital, for six consecutive days, striking the civilian airport, an airbase, and fuel depots, causing a nationwide fuel crisis. Drones also attacked the city of Kassala on the Eritrean border to the east, as well as other cities. All of this prompted army forces moving toward El Fasher to withdraw and focus on protecting eastern Sudan, as the BBC reported on 10/5/2025. Does this mean that the attack on eastern Sudan is aimed at removing the army from Darfur, leaving it exclusively under the control of the Rapid Support Forces (RSF)? Are these events a prelude to the Jeddah Platform (negotiation conference)? Or are there other objectives? Thank you.

Answer:

To uncover the motives behind the drone attacks on vital targets in eastern Sudan, we clarify the following:

First: The developments that preceded the powerful attacks on eastern Sudan, especially on Port Sudan:

1- The Sudanese army achieved major successes by expelling the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) from the important central cities of Khartoum, Bahri, and Omdurman. This major victory boosted the morale of the Sudanese army, which began preparing to pursue the Rapid Support Forces in Darfur. This increased the army's morale to pursue the RSF which is considered normal after these successes. This trend forces leaders to adapt to the new reality under popular pressure and pressure from low-ranking army officers, i.e., those who are not familiar with external dynamics:

"The Chairman of the Sudanese Sovereignty Council, Abdel Fattah al-Burhan, affirmed on Thursday the army's determination to liberate the country from "mercenaries and agents and eliminate the Rapid Support Forces (RSF)." (Anadolu Agency, 13/3/2025). This statement was intended to adapt to the new reality, and given the significant impact this reality has had on the people and within the army, army sectors have begun to clash with the RSF in some areas of Darfur. Army forces have valiantly defended their positions. The city of El Fasher is the only one of the five Darfur capitals that remains under army control. The Sudanese army began to rush towards

Darfur.

"The latest developments on the ground indicate the advance of massive army and joint force units from the northern city of Ad-Dabba to lift the siege on El Fasher, while other forces affiliated with the same factions rushed to Kordofan states and achieved significant victories on their way to the city from another axis." (Al-Quds Al-Arabi, 19/4/2025). This trend, which the people are pushing for after Khartoum's victories and has a strong resonance within the army, is not the American approach. Therefore, Al-Burhan tried to limit this trend. (Al-Burhan warned against the misinformation campaigns promoting the idea that the war targets specific ethnicities, stressing that "our war is against the person who bears arms against the state, not against any tribe," considering that these rumors aim to "mobilize people and drag them into killing." He explained that "the rebellion of a tribal leader does not mean the rebellion of the entire tribe," (RT, 29/4/2025). It was as if he wanted to stop the army's rush towards Darfur, given that some tribes there believe the army is against them, as if he was asking for a delay.

2- After the bitter defeats suffered by the RSF in the central region and the loss of their major positions in Khartoum, Bahri and Omdurman, as well as the loss of many of their fighters and field commanders, they were cloaked in defeat and weakness. They then headed towards their stronghold in Darfur, most of which they controlled, and laid siege to the city of El Fasher. This assembly of the Rapid Support Forces was in accordance with American directives towards Sudan. It is only natural, given the circumstances, that some of RSF would disperse and face difficulty in recruiting from loyal tribes, given that they were fighting losing battles against a strong opponent, the Sudanese army. This means that the morale of the RSF was low. Therefore, the army forces inside El Fasher were sufficient to repel their repeated attacks, meaning that their attack on El Fasher lacked momentum. Therefore, a major effort was necessary to restore morale to Hemedti's forces and demonstrate their superiority and strength, and their ability to strike and threaten remote areas that were safe for the Sudanese army, such as eastern Sudan.

3- Despite their rulers' allegiance to the British, the United Arab Emirates has continued to support America's agent and commander of the Rapid Support Forces (RSF), Mohamed Hamdan Dagalo (Hemedti), in the hope of gaining influence over him and his followers.

This action is similar to what it is doing in Libya by supporting America's agent, Haftar. Sudan has repeatedly expressed its disapproval with the UAE and accused it of providing significant military aid to the RSF. In response to these accusations, the UAE closed its embassy in Sudan and did not move it to Port Sudan, as other countries have done after the outbreak of war in Khartoum in April 2023. However, Sudan continued to maintain its embassy and consulate in the UAE. In light of this anger and its exacerbation, Sudan filed a lawsuit against the UAE with the International Court of Justice, accusing it of participating in the genocide carried out by the RSF in Sudan. However, the court rejected this Sudanese request:

“The court on Monday said it could not judge the case against the UAE, rejected Sudan's request for emergency measures and ordered the case be removed from its docket.” (Reuters, 6/5/2025). Sudan then took another harsh action against the UAE, severing diplomatic relations with the UAE and withdrawing the Sudanese embassy and consulate. Then, events related to the UAE continued. “The Sudanese army announced on Sunday the destruction of an Emirati cargo plane carrying military supplies to the Rapid Support Forces... It stated that the plane was carrying military supplies, including suicide drones and strategic drones.” (Sudan Tribune, 4/5/2025).

Second: Motives for these developments and their consequences:

1- With the escalation of clashes in Khartoum since 2023, the Sovereignty Council was forced to temporarily relocate the capital to Port Sudan, considering it the safest area. Foreign diplomatic missions, international relief organizations, and many residents who fled the central region for safety relocated with the Sovereignty Council members, becoming refugees. This region represents Sudan's lifeline during the war — as it houses the port that brings in goods from abroad and the country's only operational international airport, with Khartoum's airport still closed despite being under army control. As both a vital artery for survival and the seat of the interim government, the continuous drone strikes over several days came as a profound shock to both the Sudanese public and the military. These attacks show that the RSF are not a force that has been broken, as some have thought, but rather possess greater capabilities than they have previously demonstrated. They also demonstrate that the army should not be scattered in the deserts of Darfur, but rather should fortify and protect these vital facilities, such as the port, airport, and fuel depots. Moreover, the severe fires that broke out in the fuel depots suggest to the army that its logistical services, necessary for the war in Darfur, have been damaged, so it must take its time and repair them before

rushing into Darfur.

2- The strikes on Port Sudan facilities, Kassala Airport, and Flamingo Naval base were carried out by heavy Chinese drones, according to analyses from several sources, including the BBC, dated 10/5/2025. One drone can carry 40 kg, while another can carry 200 kg of explosives and guided missiles. The RSF have never used such drones before. Similar drones have been spotted at Nyala Airport, which is controlled by the Rapid Support Forces. This is the same airport where the army said it destroyed the Emirati cargo plane.

3- The UAE was among the first countries in the region to acquire Chinese drones years ago. On 2/5/2019, Defense News reported that the UAE used these drones to support Khalifa Haftar in his attacks on Tripoli, Libya. Times Aerospace reported that the UAE used these Chinese drones to strike jihadist sites in Iraq and Afghanistan in 2014. This means that the UAE has been armed with various heavy types of Chinese drones for many years, and it is likely that they are behind these attacks in eastern Sudan, either directly from the sea or by supplying them to the RSF. They are outraged by Burhan government's defamation of them in the International Court, the severing of relations with them, and the destruction of their cargo plane.

4- The focus of the strikes was on airports, the port, and the Flamingo naval base. Fires often broke out, taking days to control, indicating that oil depots were being targeted. The Sudanese Minister of Energy and Petroleum, Muhieddin Mohamed Naeem, revealed that five major oil storage depots were burned as a result of drone strikes on the first day of the campaign (Voice of Sudan, 6/5/2025). Due to the continued targeting of energy facilities, the same minister issued directives to shut down the pipeline carrying South Sudan's oil due to the drone bombing of the oil pumping station east of Atbara (Al Jazeera Net, 11/5/2025).

5- The targeting focused on fuel, to deprive the Sudanese army of it, which would prevent it from launching major operations in Darfur, especially in the city of El Fasher. This is in addition to showing the government in a weak position, as it is unable to secure its headquarters, as well as secure fuel and electricity for all of Sudan's needs. “The Sudanese Electricity Company announced that “the Sudanese electricity station was damaged as a result of being targeted by drones and the power outage.”” (Anadolu Agency, 8/5/2025)

6- It is clear from all this that the major attacks in eastern Sudan, especially on the strategic facilities of the city of Port Sudan, are linked to the war in Darfur. They are

aimed at forcing the army to move away from attacking El Fasher and head east to defend Port Sudan. The BBC reported on 10/5/2025, that the army forces moving towards El Fasher were forced by the attack on eastern Sudan to return and focus on protecting eastern Sudan.

Third: Conclusion of these Events

1- It is likely that, after these heavy strikes, the Sudanese army has begun to fear the new capabilities of the Rapid Support Forces and is losing access to the fuel needed to operate its vehicles in the war it planned for El Fasher and Darfur in general. This is in addition to the need to fortify eastern Sudan for fear of further waves of attacks, thereby reducing the army's pressure on Darfur and its preoccupation with the eastern front.

2- Regarding the RSF, its forces will gain momentum and be in a better morale to achieve results in El Fasher, all with support from the UAE and the provision of heavy Chinese drones.

3- It is expected that the attacks on El Fasher will intensify and that the army sectors that were on their way to support El Fasher will retreat, and that the Sovereignty Council will take time to repair this devastation in eastern Sudan. It is unlikely that the Jeddah negotiations will start again before the RSF take control of El Fasher, or have weight in it, which is important in Darfur. Then America will create a balance of power and control between the two Sudanese forces (the army and the Rapid Support Forces), so that if the Jeddah negotiations are resumed, the RSF will have thrown off the cloak of defeat and will stand confident in their strength and the stability of their control and have established a de facto government in Darfur, that is, creating the appropriate conditions for the division to mature and become a reality that must be accepted

Fourth: It is painful that the kaffir colonial America can manage a fight that reaps lives in Sudan and harness its agents to implement it openly, not secretly, and publicly, not hidden. Burhan and Hemedti are fighting with the blood of the people of Sudan for no reason other than to serve America's interests, as it wants to repeat the division of Sudan as it did in separating the south from Sudan. It is now doing its utmost to separate Darfur from what remains of Sudan. Therefore, the army focuses its attention on the rest of Sudan's regions, and the RSF focus their attention on Darfur. If the sincere in the army become active in regaining control of Darfur, the RSF will move the battle to other regions in Sudan to distract the army, so its forces withdraw from Darfur to eastern Sudan, in which the RSF are intensifying their attacks with drones. This is to enable the RSF to take complete

control of Darfur!

In conclusion, we call upon you in the same manner as we called upon you in our previous response dated 19/12/2023:

O our People in the Sudan of the Great Islam... The Sudan of Dongola Mosque, the first mosque built by the first Muslims in Sudan... The Sudan of the great Islamic conquest during the era of Caliph Othman, may Allah be pleased with him, where he ordered the governor of Egypt to bring the light of Islam to Sudan, so he sent the soldiers of Islam led by Abdullah Ibn Abi Al-Sarh, and the opening took place in the year 31 AH. And so, Islam spread rapidly, with Allah's favour, until it filled all of Sudan: from its north to its south and from its east to its west... Then it continued during the era of the Muslim caliphs.

O our people in Sudan, who fought against the British from 1896 until mid-World War I in 1916, when the pious and strong hero, Ali bin Dinar, the Wali (governor) of Darfur, was martyred. That scholar and fighter was credited with repairing the Miqat of Medina and the people of Ash-Sham, Dhu al-Hulaifah, and constructing wells for watering pilgrims, which are still named after him today, Abyar Ali.

O our people in Sudan, we call upon you to rectify the situation before regret sets in, for there is no time for regret. Take control of the two warring parties and support them firmly on the right path. Support Hizb ut Tahrir in establishing the Khilafah Rashidah (Rightly-Guided Khilafah), for in it lies the glory of Islam and Muslims and the humiliation of kufr (disbelief) and disbelievers. And the pleasure of Allah is greater.
